Please DO NOT use flash photography when the dogs are competing.

We will be using a "rolling podium" system. In each semi final and final, or 2nd run of combined events, the top 3 places will be awarded as soon as the last dog in that height runs. Once all heights have finished, if you are not fortunate enough to gain a top 3 placement, all finalists and semi-finalists (depending on event) will come into the arena and receive a commemorative rosette.

## Show Information

**Camping** No arrivals prior to **5pm** on Thursday 31st August

Electric hook up points will be found on the left hand side of the camping area. All tents will be in the middle of the camping area so nothing will spook the horses who have a riding track passing the camping. There are electric gates from the camping area to the arena. Please do not walk on the road as this can cause issues with the sensors in the gates. We will have evening entertainment on Friday night.

There will be a skip and 2 portaloos near the camping area. The main toilets and showers at Kelsall Hill will be open 24 hours. Please do not take any dogs into the toilets or showers.

Down in the car park there is a wooden cupboard - containing 3 vending machines, which have hot drinks, chocolate and snacks.

The on-site cafe will be open from 7am until 8pm offering a range of food including vegetarian and vegan for breakfast, lunch and dinner. Alcohol can be purchased from the cafe too. Please support the cafe as much as possible.

All dogs have to be on a lead whilst on site. Off lead exercise can be taken in the woods **only**. Follow the clearly signposted sand track from the car park, with your dog on the lead, up into the woods. Anyone with their dogs off lead, other than those competing, in any other areas of the venue will be asked to leave immediately and no refund will be given.

Please note as well as the grand finals running there will be a show jumping competition too in the outdoor arenas. Please pick up after your dogs and dispose of their poo in the clearly marked bins.

Each competitor will be able to collect a wristband for entry to spectate for all three days of the tournament, plus an additional spectator wristband for a groom for each day they are competing.

Additional spectator wristbands can be purchased on the day for £5.



The clothing and wristband collection point will be open from 7am and is separate to the event check in times below:
